Great American Wheat Harvest Documentary Film Maker Wins Silver Telly Award for Movie Trailer

Frederick, MD – May 30, 2012 – Amongst nearly 11,000 entries from 50 states and numerous countries, Maryland-based independent filmmaker, Conrad Weaver of ConjoStudios, LLC, recently was named a Silver award winner in the 33rd Annual Telly Awards for the GREAT AMERICAN WHEAT HARVEST [documentary movie trailer](#).

Set to release Spring 2014, the [Great American Wheat Harvest](#) documentary will follow the wheat harvest 10-state region from Texas up to the Canadian border, featuring the stories of America's wheat producers and the hard-working harvesting crews.
